

PLACES TO VISIT

GENERAL GEORGE PATTON MUSEUM

A world famous military museum featuring personal and military items from the legendary life of General George S. Patton, Jr.

KENTUCKY MUSEUM OF AMERICAN POCKETKNIVES

A historical display of W.R. Case & Sons Cutlery items, knives, documents, pictures, and artifacts. Located outside is the World's Largest Pocketknife, confirmed by Guinness World Records.



BRIDGES TO THE PAST WALKING TRAIL

Scenic paved trail along the historic L&N Turnkpike featuring 16 points of interest including 150 year old stone bridges. Call before you visit to ensure trail is open.

BOUNDARY OAK DISTILLERY

Get into the real spirit of Kentucky by experiencing the art and process of fine bourbon making through self-guided tours and personal tastings.

THE KENTUCKY SEPTEMBER 11TH MEMORIAL

As a tribute to the victims of 9/11, this beautiful monument is constructed from steel, recovered from the World Trade Center in New York, and stones from the Pentagon.





HARDIN COUNTY SCHOOLS PERFORMING ARTS CENTER

A community theater featuring the talents of local performers and a variety of productions in comedy, drama, mystery and music.

UNITED STATES BULLION DEPOSITORY

The facility, known as "The Gold Vault," houses the largest portion of the United States gold reserve. *No Visitors Permitted*.

THE KENTUCKY VETERANS CEMETERY

A serene and beautiful resting place dedicated to those who have served and their families.



SAUNDERS SPRINGS NATURE PRESERVE

Stroll, hike or bike in a picturesque forest featuring waterfalls and historic cabins.

TIOGA FALLS HIKING TRAIL

Two mile hiking trail that meanders through a peaceful, natural environment. Call before you visit to ensure trail is open.

FORT DUFFIELD

The oldest Union Civil War fortification in Kentucky and is on the National Register of Historic Places.
